

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

If the unit is not positioned in a stable location, it can be potentially hazardous due to falling. Many injuries, particularly to children, can be avoided by taking simple precautions such as:

- Using cabinets or stands recommended by the manufacturer of the unit.
- Only use furniture that can safely support the unit.
- Ensure the CTOUCH interactive display is not hanging over the edge of the supporting furniture.
- Do not place the CTOUCH interactive display on tall furniture (for example, cupboards or bookcases) without anchoring both the furniture and the CTOUCH interactive display to a suitable support.

- To avoid possible condensation it is recommended to not use the device within 24 hours after its arrival.

But improper use can result in potential electric shock or fire hazard. In order to prevent potential danger, please observe the following instructions when installing, operating and cleaning the product. To ensure your safety and prolong the service life of your CTOUCH interactive display, please read the following precautions carefully before using the product.

1. **Read these instructions** - All operating instructions must be read and understood before the product is used.
2. **Keep these instructions** - These safety and operating instructions must be kept in a safe place for future reference.
3. **Note all warnings** - All warnings on the product and in the instruction manual must be observed closely.
4. **Follow all instructions** - All operating instructions must be followed.
5. **Attachments** - Only use attachments/accessories specified by the manufacturer. Do not use attachments which are not recommended by the manufacturer. Use of improper attachments can result in accidents.
6. **Power source** - This product is intended to be supplied with a listed power supply indicated on the marking label. If you are not sure of the type of power supply at your location, consult your product dealer or local power company. For added protection for this product during a lightning storm, or when it is left unattended and unused for a long period of time, unplug it from the wall outlet and disconnect the cable system.
7. **Power cord protection** - Protect the power cord from being walked on or pinched particularly at plugs, wall outlet, and the point where they exit from the device.

IMPORTANT SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

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8. **Overloading** - Do not overload wall outlets, extension cords, or convenience receptacles on other equipment as this can result in a risk of fire or electric shock.
 9. **Entering of objects and liquids** - Never insert an object into the product through vents or openings. High voltages are present in the product and inserting an object can cause electric shock and/or short circuit internal parts. For the same reason, do not spill water or liquid on the product.

18. **Do not use this device near water** - for example near a bathtub, washbowl, kitchen sink, laundry tub, in a wet basement or near a swimming pool. The device should not be exposed to dripping or splashing liquids and that no objects filled with liquids, such as vases, shall be placed on the device.
19. **Cleaning** - Unplug the device from the power before cleaning. Do not use liquid cleaners or aerosol cleaners. Use a soft lint-free cloth for cleaning.

Do not use in hot and cold rooms (locations)

- When the unit is used in rooms (locations) with low temperature, the picture may leave trails or appear slightly delayed. This is not a malfunction. The unit will recover when the temperature returns to normal.
- Do not leave the unit in a hot or cold location. Also, do not leave the unit in a location exposed to direct sunlight, near a heater or in high humidity, as this may cause the cabinet to deform and the screen to malfunction and affect the CTOUCH interactive display's performance.


CAUTIONS BEFORE CONNECTING

- When connecting an external device to the CTOUCH interactive display, make sure that the CTOUCH and the external device are turned off.
- Check the plugs at the ends of the cables to make sure that they are the correct type before plugging them into the sockets on the CTOUCH interactive display.
- Make sure that all plugs are securely inserted into the sockets. Loose connections can result in image, colour or sound problems.
- The illustration of the external device may be different depending on your model.
- Refer to the operating manual of the external device as well.
- Before using headphones, adjust the device volume to avoid excessive volume, as hearing damage may result.
- The CTOUCH interactive display is designed with multiple USB port (3.0 or 2.0), if you want to connect a USB device, please select the appropriate port.
- Connect TOUCH OUT with USB cable to PC USB port.
- Connect PC with VGA, DP or HDMI cable. Please choose the proper method of connection based on your device.
- This product should be operated only from the type of power source indicated on the marking label.
- Always unplug the AC cord from power outlet when you won't use the screen for a long period of time.

CONNECTIONS

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1. Connect the female plug to the AC socket on the unit.

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BASIC OPERATIONS

TURNING THE CTOUCH INTERACTIVE DISPLAY ON OR OFF

1. Plug the power cord into an AC power outlet.
2. Press Power Switch on the CTOUCH interactive display.
3. Now the CTOUCH is in standby mode. Wait a moment until the power indicator lights up, then press  button to turn on the CTOUCH interactive display.

IN CASE OF FIRST TIME INSTALLATION

- a. Select desired menu language, then press START and go to the next page.



- b. Select location and go to the next page.



4. Press  button again to turn the CTOUCH interactive display into stand-by mode.
5. To cut off the power completely, use the Power Switch.

REMOTE CONTROL

Problem	Possible Solutions
Remote control does not operate	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Make sure the CTOUCH interactive display is switched on. Check the orientation of the batteries. The batteries could be weak. Replace the batteries.

VIDEO AND AUDIO

Problem	Possible Solutions
No picture (screen not lit) but no sound	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Make sure a (red or white) light is visible in the home button. Press power on the CTOUCH interactive display or on the remote control. Test another source.
Dark, poor or no picture (screen lit) but good sound	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Select a proper picture mode. Adjust the brightness in the video setting. Test another source.
No color, dark picture or abnormal color	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Adjust the color saturation in the video setting.
Good picture but no sound	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The sound may be muted. Press mute again to cancel.
Audio noise	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Communication problems may occur if infrared communication equipment (e.g., infrared cordless headphones) is used near the CTOUCH interactive display. Move the infrared communication equipment away from the CTOUCH until the noise is eliminated.
